Topic: Occupational Exposure Banding – Keep This in Your Toolbelt

The reality is that there are far more chemicals without OELs than with OELs. Not everyone realizes – When an OEL isn't available, it should not be assumed that a substance is safe. What is a safety professional to do in this situation? The Occupational Exposure Banding process can help professionals walk through the available data and critical questions to determine – with a consistent logic – a possible classification based upon little data to more data.
